

09-10 DRESS CODE

OPTIONAL: (boys & girls)

Long sleeve undershirts/turtlenecks must be the same color as the outer polo shirt worn.

White short sleeve undershirts must not have any writing and may be worn under polo shirt. Undershirts must be fitted and not shown on the outside of the polo shirt.

Sweaters/fleece jackets (navy or white w/ open front & no logos, brand names or designs)

HCS will offer monogrammed sweatshirts (These may be purchased only at HCS). These must be worn with appropriate school polo shirt underneath on Mon., Tues., Thurs., & Fri. (**not with chapel attire**)

Boys

Girls

ALL hair bows, accessories & clothing items must coordinate with uniform colors of white, navy, red, hunter green & khaki. All students have a 2-week grace period at the beginning of the year. Each student will be allowed one warning per year for dress code violations before conduct points are deducted – **2 points per violation**. All uniform guidelines must be followed for overnight field trips also. Field trips that include swimming – girls must wear a full-cover t-shirt/over shirt with swimsuits and boys must keep their shirts on with their swim shorts.

UNIFORM INFORMATION:

- All plaid items and monogrammed hunter green shirts must be purchased from Parker Uniforms.

- The solid color shirts in navy, hunter green, red and white may be purchased from any clothing store (preferably JCPenney).
- The navy or khaki pants, shorts, skorts, capris and skirts must be no more than 3" above the knee and may be purchased from any clothing store (preferably JCPenney).
- Footwear must be low-cut tennis shoes or flat, closed toe, closed heel shoe or lace up dress shoe for comfort and safety. No cleats, flip-flops, roller shoes, sandals, boots, open toe or open back shoes are allowed.
- Socks or tights must be worn with all shoes. Socks must be visible above the shoe.
- All shorts or pants with belt loops must be belted (black or brown) for K-5 & above.
- No headgear for girls or boys. Caps, hats or bandanas are not permitted.
- All shirts must have a collar with sleeves and be long enough to stay tucked in for the entire day.
- All pants and shorts must be trouser style (flat front or pleats), not excessively baggy or tight.
- No cargo pants allowed.
- No low rise pants (must fit at natural waist or above).
- No frayed or torn pants.
- Belts must be solid in color with no ornamentation.
- Heavy coats may be worn into building but, kept in lockers or hung on hook during class time.
- No sweatpants or suites worn except during P.E. for students in 5th grade and above.

PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The following are guidelines for our students to follow in their personal appearance. If these guidelines are not met to the discretion of our staff, a color change may be given and 2 points deducted from their conduct grade. All students are allowed a 2-week grace period at the beginning of the school year, after the grace period students are allowed 1 warning per year, after warning 2-points will be deducted per violation.

Males are not allowed to wear earrings or heavy jewelry. Body piercing is not allowed on males or females except; girls may have a limit of two earrings per ear. No dangling jewelry due to safety issues. Students' hair must be a common color and style. Boys' hair must be cut at the top of the eyebrow, ear, & collar. A teacher's discretion may be used in considering a style as ungroomed. Anything that draws attention to a child or sets them apart in any fashion is not permitted. Makeup is limited to girls in the 6th grade and up. Excessive makeup is not allowed; it must be lightly applied. No tattoos are allowed, washable or permanent.
